

Asbestos Management Plan

As a result of the Federal Law AHERA (Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act), all primary and secondary schools are required to develop and implement a plan for managing all building materials that contain asbestos. Included in the AHERA Act is the requirement to notify all parents, guardians and staff members as well as organizations representing them, of activities and events with the asbestos-containing building materials annually.

In compliance with the federal Asbestos Hazardous Emergency Response Act (AHERA), the Greendale School District has prepared an Asbestos Management Plan for all district-owned buildings. Copies of our Management Plan and Inspection Reports are available upon request for review at each school office and at the District Office.
