GREENDALE, WI – The Greendale Board of Education announced today it has accepted the resignation of Dr. John Tharp from his position as superintendent of Greendale Schools.

“We thank Dr. Tharp for his years of service to Greendale Schools and its students,” said Mr. Joe Crapitto, president of the Greendale Board of Education. “We wish him all the best in his future endeavors.”

Crapitto added, “Greendale schools remain a destination district for families and staff. Our village can take pride in our academic, artistic, and athletic achievements. The Board and the administrative team will work together to ensure a smooth transition takes place for families, students and staff.”

The Board of Education will develop a search process in the coming weeks. During the interim, the District will be led by Kim Amidzich, Director of Curriculum & Instruction, who will work closely with other District administrators and the building principals. The District administrators will work collaboratively during this transition.

Tharp was hired as superintendent of Greendale Schools in August 2012 following the departure of former superintendent, Dr. William Hughes.
