GREENDALE SCHOOLS LAUNCHES SUPERINTENDENT SEARCH Online Survey OPENS to Gather Resident Input

GREENDALE, WI - Greendale Schools has posted an online survey to gather community input in creating a profile for its permanent superintendent of schools. The survey link is located on the Greendale Schools' website, "Superintendent Search Update" page. Please follow this [link](#) and click on the green "Superintendent Search Survey" button on the top of the page. The survey will be available to collect responses until November 25.

Additionally, the District will hold three Parent/Community Forums to gather resident input in this profile-building process. The meetings will be held on Tuesday, November 10, and Wednesday, November 11, in the Greendale High School Multipurpose Room (cafeteria); and Tuesday, November 17, in the Greendale High School library. All meetings begin at 6:30 p.m. Greendale High School is located at 6801 Southway, Greendale. Childcare will be available.

Data from the survey and community input gathered from the meetings will help the District develop a profile of attributes for the new leader to provide the foundation for a superintendent recruitment and selection process unique to Greendale.

These community forums will be conducted by Dr. JoAnn Sternke, current superintendent of the Pewaukee School District, who is a local consultant for School Exec Connect, the firm hired to conduct the search process for Greendale Schools. The New Superintendent Profile is projected to be completed for presentation at the December 7 School Board meeting.
